Dear Mayor and Council,

To move the solar array project along, I'd like to request an electronic special council meeting during the noon hour on either Weds or Thurs of this week.

--1.) The first item concerns hiring a consultant to help us evaluate the RFP responses that we receive. Originally, we were going to try to evaluate the responses in-house with Jon and me. But, a consultant that we're aware of, Warren McKenna, has done these projects and will likely save us money by helping us evaluate the best value for the City. That is, not necessarily the lowest cost, but the best proposal for the money.

His quote is \$125 per hour with a not-to-exceed of \$5000 for 40 hours. I'm hoping that a recommendation doesn't take 40 hours to determine.

At this time, I'd like us to hold off on his second proposal which is for construction oversight. There's a chance that Terry might be able to do this for us. But, we'll know more about that based on the proposals that come in and whether the City accepts one of them.

--2.) We hadn't anticipated this item. Mostly due to the slope of the site, the most serious of the solar array contractors have asked for a topo survey of the site. Altogether and if needed to its fullest extent, this proposal will come to \$7550. It is being made by an engineering firm (Hart-Frederick in Tiffin) that has also done solar projects before. The topo would also cover that remaining 6 acres to the west of the primary project site—in case we do a second solar project in the future.

This is from the email that they used as their proposal:

"This estimate includes \$2250 for retracement of parcel & determining, monumenting access, \$2000 for topographic survey and deliver, \$800 for Environmental Review Request and \$2500 for NPDES permit.

At this time, upon given the go ahead for your City Council, we will be able to do the retracement survey and topographic survey delivered within 2 to 3 weeks, unless otherwise requested for an earlier or later timeframe.

The Environmental Review we will begin as soon as given approval and the NPDES permit we will begin as soon as we know the lay of the land and determine its extents." With this, the storm water permit (\$2500) would start by publishing at "notice of intent" in the paper. If the project isn't pursued, then we'd only be out of the cost of doing that.
